History

The Philip Livingston Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution was established in Howell, Michigan in 1908. In 2008, the chapter, still flourishing, celebrated its 100th anniversary.

Scope and Content Note

The records of the Philip Livingston Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution consist of scrapbooks of clippings and albums of photographs, yearbooks, award citations, and newspaper articles. The records cover the period of 1948 to 1958 and 1984 to 2008. At present, there is no documentation for the 1960s and 70s.
