History

Vogel's & Wurster's was a Chelsea, Michigan mercantile establishment. The firm was known as H.S. Holmes Mercantile Company from the 1880s to about 1916. The firm was then reorganized as Vogel's & Wurster's. Dallas H. Wurster and Edward Vogel had previously served as secretary and treasurer of the Holmes firm. Sometime after World War II, the store was renamed Vogel's & Foster's.

Scope and Content Note

The Vogel & Wurster business records consists of ledgers, financial journals, and other business records primarily in the period when the firm was known as H.S. Holmes Mercantile Company from the 1880s to about 1916.
