OFFICIAL RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS

(Issued by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1—FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2—RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a net figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3—FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is no pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team.

The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty, under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4—LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling—Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards, then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving". Player B is credited with NO pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving". Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing".)

(Approved Ruling—Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns". Player B is credited with NO return and with 5 yards under "punt returns".)

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing". If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5—TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of net gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are **not** included in total offense.

Michigan won the toss and elected to receive. Indiana will defend the south goal. Hall's kickoff was returned by Barr from the M7 to the M32. 1d-10. Barr inside right end for 6. 2d-4. Branoff around left end for 41 yards and a first down on the I 21. Barr around right end for 5. 2d-5. Branoff over left tackle for 4. 3d-1. Maddock over center for 4 and a first down on the I8. Baldacci over right guard for 1. 2d-7. Barr at right tackle for 3. 3d-4. Barr over right guard for 4 yards and a MICHIGAN touchdown at 4:21. Maddock held while Kramer's conversion was good. MICHIGAN 7, INDIANA 0.

Branoff's kickoff was returned by Crowe from the I 11 to the I 32. 1d-10. Cichowski at left guard for 1. 2d-9. Bartkiewicz (Bart.) over left tackle for 1. 3d-8. Bart on a delayed buck over left guard for 5. 4d-3. Cichowski's punt was taken by Barr on the M 17 and he returned to the M 36.

1d-10. Baldacci at right guard for 5 but an offensive illegal use of the hands penalty brought the ball back to the M 21. 1d-25. Hickey lost 6 at left end. 2d-31. Baldacci at right guard for 1. 3d-30. Maddock quick-kicked 52 yards to the I 32.

1d-10. Cichowski to Bomba incomplete. 2d-10. Cichowski to Johnson incomplete. 3d-10. Cichowski to Johnson incomplete. 4d-10. Cichowski's punt was downed by Indiana's Campbell on the M 32.

1d-10. Barr at right guard for no gain. 2d-10. Barr to Maddock incomplete. 3d-10. Barr's pass was caught by Maentz on the M 45 and he was down on the M 47. 1d-10. Baldacci around right end for 8. 2d-2. Maddock over center for 4 and a first down on the I 41. Baldacci at right guard for 2. 2d-8. Maddock's pass was caught by Barr on the I 29 and he raced to the I 20 for a first down, an overall gain of 19. 1d-10. Branoff at left guard for 2. 2d-8. Barr made 3 over left guard, fumbled, and the ball was recovered by Hall of Indiana on the I 14.

1d-10. Cichowski over center for 3. 2d-7. Campbell at right tackle for 2. 3d-5. Kun around right end for 1. 4d-4. Cichowski's punt was taken by Barr on the M 46 and he returned to the I 42.

SECOND QUARTER

(Play situation: Michigan has the ball on the Indiana 42. 1d-10.) Branoff around left end for 7. 2d-3. Pace at right guard for 6 but an offensive illegal procedure penalty brought the ball back to the I 40. 2d-8. Baldacci at right guard for 2. 3d-6. Pace, attempting to pass, found no receiver and raced around left end for 18 yards and a first down on the I 20. Pace inside right end for 20 yards and a Michigan touchdown, which was not called back. Maddock held while Kramer kick the extra point. MICHIGAN 14, INDIANA 0 at 1:32.

Branoff's kickoff was returned 12 yards by Cichowski to the I 27. 1d-10. Cichowski lost 1 at center. 2d-11. Crowe at left tackle for 6. 3d-5. Hendricks at right end for no gain but an offensive illegal use of the hands penalty put the ball on the M 34. 1d-25. Maddock to Hendricks incomplete. ~~but~~ A personal foul penalty against Indiana on the play brought the ball ~~up~~ up to the M 49 (play counts). 2d-10. Hickey at left guard for 2. 3d-8. Maddock to Hill complete for a loss of 3 yards. 4d-12. Maddock's punt was returned by Crowe from the I 13 to the I 23.

Barr at right tackle for 5 but an offensive illegal procedure penalty brought the ball back to the M 40. 2d-12. Branoff around left end for 7. 3d-5. Baldacci at left guard for 4. 4d-1. Baldacci leaped over right tackle for 4 and a first down on the I 45. Barr lost 1 around right end. 2d-11. Branoff to Kramer incomplete. 3d-11. Branoff around left end for 7. 4d-4.
