Michigan won the toss and elected to defend the south goal. M. S. U. will receive. Kramer's kick was taken by Peakes on the 5. He returned to the 26. 1-10. Peake, at right for 1. 2-9. Kowlaczyk at left end got 2. 3-7. Peake at right tackle for 4. 4-3. Peake's punt partially blocked by Maentz on the M 35. 1-10

Herrnstein over center for 6. 2-4. Barr at right guard for 2. 3-2 Van Pelt on a quarterback sneak made 11 and a first down on the MSU 46. 1-10. Barr stopped after no gain. 2-10. Barr over rt. tackle for 3. 3-7. Van Pelt pass to Ptacek complete for 9. and a first down on the state 34. 1-0. Herrnstein over left guard for 7. 2-3/ Ptacek made 1 over rt. tackle for 1. 3-2. Van Pelt's jump to Kramer complete for 7. and a 1st. down on the S 19. 1-10. Van Pelt's pass to Kramer was incomplete. 2-10. Herrnstein over center for 2. 3-8. Van Pelt lost 3. 4-11. Kramer's attempted field goal was wide. States ball on their own 20. 1-10 on the 20. Wilson over rt. guard for 4. ~~Kow~~/Arend over rt. guard for 2. 3-4. Wulff made 3 at left end. 4-1. Peaks punt went out of bounds on the M 21. 1-10...Michigan.

Herrnstein over center for 5. 2-5. Barr made 20 yds around left end aided by a key block by Herrnstein. 1-10. Ptacek made no gain at rt. end. 2-10. Herrnstein over left guard for 7. 3-3. Herrnstein made 6 over center and a 1st. down on the state 41. 1-10. Ptacek at left tackle made 3. 2-7. Ptacek's jump pass ~~to~~ to Kramer complete but a backfield in motion penalty made it 2-12. Van Pelt's pass to Shannon incomplete 3-12. Van Pelt was trapped for an 8 yd. loss 4-20. Van Pelt's punt was downed by Orwig on the S. 19. 1-10.

Matskos kick-off taken by Van Pelt on the 30 and returned to the M 40. 1-10. Pace's pass to Maentz complete for 8. 2-2. Van Pelt's pass to Kramer incomplete but an offside penalty made it 2-7. Pace around right end for 4. 3-3. Pace was run out-of-bounds for a 1 yard loss. 4-4. Maddock's punt was taken by Peaks on the 8 and returned to the S 10.

Peaks made 9 thru center. 2-1. Gilbert made 2 diving over center. 1-10 on the S 21. Peaks made 2 thru right guard. 2-8. Gilbert made 2 thru right tackle. Peaks made 3 thru center. 4-3. Peaks' punt was taken by Barr on the M 25 and returned to the M 38. 1-10.

Maddock's pass to Pace incomplete. 2-10. Maddock's pass to Byers complete for 3. 3-7. Pace elected to run around right end and made no gain. 4-7. Maentz's punt went into the endzone for a touchback.

State's ball 1-10 on their own 20. Wulff made 5 at left end. 2-5. Peaks made 1 at right guard. 3-4. Peaks ran thru right tackle for 6 and a first down on the MS 32. 1-10. Panitch lost 1 before his fumble was recovered by Rotunno on the S 31.
