Michigan Football Facts  
fourth

Today's game marks the ~~fourth~~ in the series between Michigan and Washington which started back in 1916 and was not resumed again until 1953 and 1954. The Huskies have never beaten Michigan and have scored just one time in the three games, that a touchdown in 1916. The last two games ended in Michigan shutouts.

Steve Hanzlik, second string quarterback for Washington, is the son of Bob Hanzlik who played football for Michigan in 1943.

Today's attendance of 49,684 is the smallest home crowd since 1963 when 48,934 watched the Ohio State game.

Jim Mandich's second reception good for 13 yards moved him past Ron Kramer and into fourth place for most yards gained by pass receiving in a career. Mandich's career total is 918 yards.

Injury sustained by Michigan's Henry Hill in the third period was diagnosed as a pulled groin muscle. How long Hill will be out of the lineup has not yet been determined.

Don Morehead had a streak of 9 straight completions, covering part of the second period, the third period, and part of the fourth.

The last time Michigan got off to such a good start (scoring-wise) was in 1947 when the Wolverines beat Michigan State 55-0 in the opener and Stanford 49-13. (The next week Michigan beat Pittsburgh 69-0).

Tom Curtis' two interceptions gave him a career total of 20.

Michigan's 34 first downs is a new club record breaking the mark of 28 set against Minnesota in 1968.

Michigan's total of 581 total yards is also a new club record breaking the old mark of 531 set against Ohio St. in 1943.

A comparison: In Ron Johnson's first two starting games he carried the ball 19 for 85 yards and 26 times for 270. In Glenn Doughty's first two starting games he has carried the ball 15 times for 138 yards and 29 for 181.



## COACHES' COMMENTS

### Washington--JIM OWENS

I can't believe that training had anything to do with it. We had a good week in Lansing. We had a good game plan offensively and defensively. But we gave the ball away early and....

We wanted to try to operate our offense but stopped ourselves with the interception and the fumble on the goal line in the first half.

I was encouraged in the first half with the score 12-0. It was a nightmare in the third quarter; ridiculous the way we played defense. I didn't recognize our ball club most of the time.

Doughty ran well but I thought we would tackle better; I was amazed with the breakdown on defense.

They didn't do anything different. I thought we'd do better on Moorhead than we did. We were either awfully slow on pass rush or they were blocking real well. We worked on everything they threw against us.

Moorhead executes real well. He's real poised. He had the ability to get the ball to his receivers and they ran good routes.

### Michigan--Bo Schembechler

Moorhead did real well even though he had a couple of bad plays. Washington was real tough inside. We had to go to the outside to beat them. Doughty played well even though he didn't get the long gainer.

We tightened up inside the twenty and don't underestimate Washington's running game.

The play where Moorhead went for a touchdown on what looked like a naked reverse was a busted play, but I think we're going to put it in.
