Michigan's first offense series saw Glen Doughty at wing back; this is the first time he has played this position.

Michigan's defense gave up its first touchdown in 3 games when Steve Burks crossed the goal line for Texas A&M in the first quarter.

Don Moorhead, NANKINGXNEGAKIVEXYAKAGEXINXKNE by half time, had equaled Ron Johnson's total yardage mark of 2440 yards. Moorhead has gained 816 rushing and 1634 passing. Moorhead and Johnson share 6th place on the Michigan's all time yardage list. (Moorhead passed Johnson in the 2nd half.)

Texas A&M's 6 first downs rushing \*\*xxxx in the first half was more than the Wolverine defense has given up in their two previous games combined.

Marty Huff's 3rd quarter interception was his 4th in 3 games. (one against Arizona, two against Washington).

Bill Taylor entered today's game with 995 career rushing yards. On his second carry of the day he passed the 1000-yard mark.

With the score 7-10 EMEKER entering the 4th quarter, it marks the first time this season Michigan has been behind going into the final 15 minutes.

Tom Darden's game ending interception was his 3rd. (one in each game thus far)
