"Just call us G-U-T -T-Y," Bo spelled it out. "That's the kind of a ball club we are. I'll say it again, G-U-T -T-Y, we the best. Why shouldn't we be No. 1," Schembechler asked.

The Michigan coach said, "That Butz (268-pound junior Purdue tackle Dave)

is the best tackle I've seen axamex since I've been at Michigan. He's just magnificent. I certainly expected Purdue to be ever bit as good as they were. DeMoss has a terrific ball club---we've seen no better---and they've just had bad luck."

Schembechler thought the call of interference against Purdue which a llowed his club to continue its drive and score in the third period was a good call. "Their man definitely interferred on the play, and we should have had the ball there at the end---before we finally got it back to score the field goal---

when the officials gave the bail to Purdue on that so-called Interception., "Bo contended. "They interferred on that play too, and we should have had the ball on the one-yard line, but everything turned out Ok."

Schembechler really took the victory in stride. "If you think I'm going to jump up and start yelling," Bo grinned, "you just might be right. But not because we don't deserve to win. Like I said, 'Why shouldn't we be No. 188x ?""



#### QUOTES FROM THE PURDUE DRESSING ROOM

A lot of questions went unanswered with Coach Bob DeMoss' terse "I won't comment on any officiating," but the tough-luck Purdue coach was free and candid with all others.

"I'm very proud of this team. It gave 125 percent out there today against a very fine football team, Michigan has a strong off-ensive line and powerful running backs, but I thought our defense was excellent.

"We did absolutely nothing new defensively and allowed them to break only two long gainers. Also, we forced them them to pass. We decided just to go out and play Michigan a tough, physical game and see who won and that's what we did. The boys played their hearts out ... they were just great.

"Michigan's defense took away our outside running game even though we tried the option and we were just unable to break anything inside on it. Maybe we played our best game of the year, but we lost.

"I was very proud of this team today. Now we have another 'big one' coming up next week (the traditional finale against Indiana) and we'll have to come up again for the same kind of play we got today," DeMoss said.

DeMoss also explained that soph Steve Burke was in at the finish because starter Gary Danielson (quarterback) had impured re-in jured his shoulder earlier on a rushing play. "We didn't want to take any chance of risking pursuan permanent injury to Gary and stuck with Steve although Danielson felt he could go back in," DeMoss explained

The loss was the fourth of the season in the last three
