"I didn't say a thing to Coin (senior kicking specialist) when I sent Dana into to try the field goal," Michigan Coach Bo Schembechler assured following his Big Ten conference winning victory over ~~Purdue~~ Purdue.

"Just call us G-U-T -T-Y," Bo spelled it out. "That's the kind of a ball club we are. I'll say it again, G-U-T -T-Y, we <sup>are</sup> the best. Why shouldn't we be No. 1," Schembechler asked.

The Michigan coach said, "That Butz (268-pound junior Purdue tackle Dave) is the best tackle I've seen ~~xxxx~~ since I've been at Michigan. He's just magnificent. QUOTES FROM THE PURDUE DRESSING ROOM

A lot of questions went unanswered with Coach Bob DeMoss' terse "I won't comment on any officiating," but the tough-luck Purdue coach was free and candid with all others.

"I'm very proud of this team. It gave 125 percent out there today against a very fine football team. Michigan has a strong offensive line and powerful running backs, but I thought our defense was excellent.
