MICHIGAN DRESSING ROOM

COACH BO SCHEMBECHLER:

Stanford deserved to win. We didn't get first downs when we needed them. We used mostly zone defense against the pass, played against the pass and I think we were playing against the pass on the winning touchdown.

That fake punt was a key play. We ran against it all week. We didn't have a slow start and did not play well offensively. We thought about the field goal when we got in there---sure we did. Stanford got off our blocks very well. I couldn't see the safety. They had the best offense we've played against this year.

If only we could have gotten a first down or two after the safety, we could have won. We just needed to get a couple of first downs.

No I don't think this loss spoils our season.

GLENN DOUGHTY: Our effort just wasn't good enough today, but I didn't really feel at all like talking now. I'm just sick. R

FRANK GUSICH: I didn't see who hit Bunce. All I knew was that the ball was there (when he recovered Bunce fumble). The interception I missed in the first quarter---i didn't know how far from the sidelines I was so I just took off but couldn't hold the ball because I worried about the bounds markers. I'll tell you this, now I know how the Dallas Cowboys feel.

MIKE KELLER: ~~(On Bill Scott's fumble)~~ Two of us hit him, but I don't know who the other guy was. It had to be Mike Taylor or Tommy Kee. The ball came loose and was right on my hip and I didn't even know it. There was a scramble and all of a sudden it rolled in front of me and I grabbed it. It was just reaction since I thought the play was dead.
