Notes on the Michigan Michigan game

Michigan's homecoming attendance of 96,284 hikes the home average for five games to 94,641, slightly more than Michigan's NCAA record of 93,894 set in 1949.....

Mark Elziga's 49 yard touchdown run was the longest play from scrimmage this season for the Wolverines.....

Michigan's rushing and total offense marks came close to the records set in 1969 against Iowa, when the Wolverines had 673 yards in total offense and 524 rushing. ~~Saturday~~ Saturday it was 620 in total offense and 521 on the ground .....

Minnesota's seven first downs (all by rushing) matches Michigan's defensive performance against Michigan State in 1973 when the Spartans had 7 first downs rushing and none passing.....

Minnesota SID department reports Michigan's total yardage was the most ever yielded by a Cal Stoll team.....

The 49-0 Michigan win matched the biggest ever ever over a Minnesota team (1966).....

Michigan's unbeaten streak is now 18. Michigan is now 38-1-1 for its last 40 regular season games.....

Michigan is a good team. You can't compare them with Ohio State. That will be decided in November. They block well and tackle well and that's the game of football....They do things we can't...You know it gets out of hand when you try to play catch up and you don't have the stuff to catch up with.....I've got kids out there who should not be playing. But they're playing and playing with courage...we are all beat up.....We thought we could play perimeter defense and shut off Franklin and his outside running. We knew we couldn't shut them off inside. They just have too much speed for us... We gave them some awfully easy scores.

Bo Schembechler ----This is just what we needed..to propel us into the final week of the season. We needed to blow someone out. ..We played Stanford, Michigan St. and Wisconsin at their best and were fortunate to win those games..It's good to get one like this. We played good football in both halves, we needed that. I'm happy too that the young kids moved the ball...I think we won the game decisively. Except for a couple of mistakes, Heater's fumble and a couple of mistakes by Franklin, we could have gotten about 60 points....Our defense was primed for Upchurch. Our plan was not to give him the big play. He's one guy who could really hurt us....I'm actually more pleased with the defense than I am with the offense....Minnesota is a better team than it showed out there today...Our interior offensive line was excellent. I can't single out any one guy. ..We're playing pretty hurt, we're gassed up, but that's part of football and you have to play over that....Our injuries are not serious.
