MICHIGAN VS. OHIO STATE QUICK FACTS

ESTIMATED ATTENDANCE: 88,000

RECORDS: Michigan 9-1 (6-1 in Big Ten), defeating Wisconsin 40-27, Stanford 51-0, Navy 70-14, Wake Forest 31-0, Michigan State 42-10, Northwestern 38-7, Indiana 35-0, Minnesota 45-0 and Illinois 38-7, while losing to Purdue 16-14. The Wolverines last year were 8-2-2 (7-1 in Big Ten).

Ohio State 8-1-1 (7-0 in Big Ten), defeating Michigan State 49-21, Penn State 12-7, Iowa 34-14, Wisconsin 30-20, Purdue 24-3, Indiana 47-7, Illinois 42-10 and Minnesota 9-3, while tying UCLA 10-10 and losing to Missouri 22-21. The Buckeyes last year were 11-1 (8-0 in Big Ten).

SERIES: 73rd meeting with Michigan leading series, 39-28-5, although the Wolverines have not won since 1971. This is the fourth consecutive year, the seventh time in the last eight years and the 13th time since 1944 that Michigan and Ohio State have staged a showdown for the Big Ten championship. Last year, Ohio State rallied for two touchdowns in the final three minutes and 18 seconds to win, 21-14. Michigan dominated the statistics but not the scoreboard as Gordon Bell and Rob Lytle rushed for 124 and 104 yards, respectively.

COACHES' RECORDS: Bo Schembechler (115-27-6 overall, 75-10-3 at 'M', 2-4-1 against Ohio State and Woody Hayes). Woody Hayes (221-64-9 overall 188-53-9 at OSU).

SCHEMBECHLER ON OHIO STATE: "This is an excellent Ohio State team. It's strength is defense. I believe this is as strong as I've ever seen an Ohio State defense. They had some people hurt early in the season when they lost a game and tied a game, but I believe they are all back and playing now. I respect the Ohio offense a great deal also. Jeff Logan and Pete Johnson are great backs and I believe the new quarterback Jim Pacenta gives them a different dimension that will be tougher for our defense to stop."
