Don James XMM, "What do you think of experts picking Michigan by 13?"

A: "I don't think they were too far off - but who are the experts? We had some opportunities and we took advantage of them. It was a whale of a football game. Michigan did a great job of throwing the football. We tried almost everything defensively against them. It just took some great playing by Jackson and Glasgow to pull the win out.

Q: about Warren Moon...

A: Warren Moon played great today ~~kw~~ but then he's played very good all year. Warren has a lot of gust and so does our offensive coordinator (Dick Scesniak). It was not expected that we could hang in there with them head to head. I was afraid going in that we could not run the football. We were able to (run) and I'm very pleased with our offensive line.

Q: Was this a perfect game by Huskies?

A: It was not a perfect game for us but I do think we played as well as we could. We knew we had to throw to beat Michigan. I knew we would have to take chances to win. I really thought before the game that Michigan was a better team than we were, but I have a lot more respect for my team right now.

Q: Did he feel going in that he would be able to stop Michigan's option?
