

COACHES QUOTES

COACH BO SCHEMBECHLER -- (On the win in general) "It was a big game. It was the most satisfying first game win ever because we had to win it and we did."

(On the low score) "In the early season the defense is ahead of the offense and the low scoring was exactly what I thought it would be with two good teams."

(On the second half defense) "We didn't do much differently except we tried to pressure and fake pressure and it was a very physical game and we used alot of players."

(On the win in general, part 2) "The most pleasing aspect of the win is I thought we blocked well. I also thought Ricks established himself, he showed speed and power."

(About Notre Dame) "Now we can talk about Notre Dame. I never mentioned Notre Dame at all until after this game. This game (Wisconsin) was the one we had to win."

COACH DAVE MC CLAIN -- (On penalties) "The penalties played a major, major factor in this game because the fans just intimated the officials out there. I don't mind the officiating, as long as the officials call them fair on both sides. I can't believe the officials allowed themselves to be intimated like that."

(On Anthony Carter) 'We tried to take things away from Carter because he's a tremendous player. He definitely is the biggest single play man in college football today. The two players we worried about coming into the game were Smith and Carter, because Carter is just plain good and Smith was bound to improve over last year." (On injuries) "Our safety Matt VandenBoom is in the hospital, probably with a concussion. The X-rays were negative but we're going to leave him here in Ann Arbor until at least tomorrow. We lost our other safety John Josten and that really hurt us because David Greenwood had to be shifted over to safety and he's never played there before." (On game in general) "The heat definitely affected us today because we never had to condition in temperatures like these since we started practice. Michigan is a good team and we're a good team and I told our guys after the game that they gave a good effort. We didn't run as well as I would have liked but that's because people missed their blocking assignments. Michigan also brought in a lot of linebackers, and showed us some new alignments when they didn't play a 5-3 stack like we prepared for during practice. Our defense really got banged up today and that really hurt us alot."
