COACH'S QUOTES

BO SCHEMBECHLER

I thought the Michigan team played real hard. The defense was outstanding. We lost the game on offensive mistakes. In the second half, penalties or something seemed to stop us on every drive.

Auburn certainly deserves to win the way they played the second half. (About the wishbone) - Certainly the wishbone was the best running offense and Auburn had three backs hard to stop. Again, I could not ask any more out of our defense. The constant penalties just killed us. The flow made Auburn's running game so effective.

(Going early in the game on 4th and 1) - We were playing to win. (Thoughts on number one team) - As long as Michigan is not number one, I don't care who is. If Auburn wins the national championship = I am for it. They are a class team but I don't have a vote.

(Defensing the wishbone) - We played three tackles hoping it would help stop the Auburn ground game, and it did a pretty good job, but we did not have any depth while Auburn was blessed with a good bit of defensive depth. I thought our defense played well enough to win. The offense did not.

Steve Smith hit his finger on a helmet in the second quarter and there was some swelling and it hampered his passing.

This is a tough loss. We expected to win. If we had gotten better offense in the second half, we would have won. I thought we would play better offensively than we did. I knew our defense would play well.

We missed opportunities right and left. We had more than enough chances to win. We kept stopping ourselves and we did not block well to establish our running game.

(Speaking of Michigan's defense) - We had guys hanging on to them and they would still pick up 10 yards.

MICHIGAN PLAYER QUOTES

Quarterback Steve Smith:

On hurt finger in second quarter: "That was a little bit of a factor. I lost the feeling in it. But it didn't affect me that much--we just didn't play well. I was still getting the ball there on time. But I couldn't throw a spiral to save my life."

"The biggest trouble I had was that I kept getting hit."

"I was definitely throwing the ball (on play that was called a fumble). I watched the replay on the screen and my arm was in motion."

"They had a good defense. We just didn't move the ball real effectively. We wanted to throw the football, but on a third down situation when they know you're going to throw the ball, that defensive line sort of pins its ears back and comes at you."

"If our offense could have moved the ball at all, they wouldn't have had the points they got."

On finger: "I don't know if it's broken or jammed."

Why didn't run option more?: "They pursue the ball really well and when you pursue the ball like that you can't run the option. So they shut it down."

Best defense you've faced this year?: "Yeah. Probably."

Strong safety Rodney Lyles:

What defense did to stop wishbone?: "We changed our defense to stop the wishbone. We did some things differently."

Hard to learn the new defense?: "Oh yeah, oh yeah. It's hard to try to stop the wishbone, but we knew it wouldn't be smooth."

Michigan defensive player quotes

#42 MIKE MALLORY:

"We're down right now...it was a hard defeat. They're a good team, but we felt we could win if we could hold them under 13 points.

"We tried to go after them and be aggressive. We didn't want to sit back. They hurt us with the counter...we seemed to be looking for the option. That play caught us off guard.

"We tried not to be tired at the end and not let it effect our play. I think we stayed with our game plan."

#14 TONY GANT:

"They read our sets and executed well. Give Auburn credit. Bo Jackson is a great back--undoubtedly an All-American."

On his near interception in the 2nd half -- "I thought I had it and that it was a clean interception. The ball popped in the air and I picked it off another player. I tried to talk to the official, but it was useless. He said, 'No interception 14' ".

#21 EVAN COOPER:

"We played a helleva game. We have nothing to be ashamed of. Auburn just got the breaks.

"We set a goal to hold them under 13 points and we accomplished that. Things just didn't go our way at critical times. We got hurt by counter and dive plays, but we made some adjustments at halftime and defended them a little bit better in the second half."

QUOTES

AUBURN COACH PAT DYE: "I'm really very humble right now. I'm not so sure I hadn't rather been playing Nebraska or Miami tonight than Michigan the way they were playing. Coach Schembechler had them ready. They played like we felt they would coming into the ballgame. They played good enough to deserve better.

"I'm just as proud of our kids for the way they played tonight as I would if they had won 45-0. The way they won, is probably more meaningful and will mean more down the line than it would if we had won by a large margin. The lessons they learned tonight and through this season will far surpass any lessons you learn in a rout.

"This is a game where we knew what was on the line coming into the game. Georgia beat Texas and whether Miami beat Nebraska tonight, I don't know. We faced a lot of adversity during the course of the game tonight. We hurt our own cause at times.

"Football is a three way thing. Fans like a lot of offense and throwing the ball around, but that's not anymore important than defense and the kicking game. In all three areas our football team excelled at times tonight. We held a Michigan team that averaged over 400 yards to 2243 . Some of that came on the last ~~two~~ two or three plays of the game. That's got to be a plus for us. Al Del Greco kicked three field goals for us and that ended up being the difference in the game. The great thing about it was our offense took the ball on a 15 play drive that ended at the two with time running out--where every play was critical --make it or break it--and we got it down close for the field goal.

"There's no question but Michigan did a great job of preparation and gave us some problems. Their quickness was a big factor. "

ON AUBURN BEING NUMBER ONE: "If Miami beats Nebraska, then Auburn should be No. 1. It's cut and dried. If they are going to have a No. 1 football team in America, and it's going to have any credibility at all--if there is any credibility in scheduling--if Nebraska loses tonight, there's no way that Auburn shouldn't be No. 1.

"Our opponents average winning 69.5 percent of their games. Texas' opponents average 59 percent of their games. Michigan--55, Nebraska--52, Miami--51. That should mean something. Playing the toughest schedule in the nation should mean something."

GREG CARR

It takes a total team effort and that is what we got. We had our problem offensively the first three quarters but the defense hung in there and in the end it was a total team effort. It was a culmination of the three working together - the offense, the defense and the kicking game.

AL DEL GRECO

(On last field goal attempt) - I don't really know what was going through my mind now. Most of all I am just happy to do something for this football team. I am extremely happy for all the Auburn people. Even if I go on and play more it will never be the same. I will always keep coming back to Auburn because I love them all.

RANDY CAMPBELL

Thank God for the defense and the kicking game. I can't really put it into words. I don't know if I was ever worried at any time or not. I've never been this happy.

BEN THOMAS

Going into the game, we knew Michigan had a great offensive line. I played as hard as I could and kept going full speed. I am glad we came out a winner. They are a great fundamental team and early in the game, the two tackles were just sitting back and cutting us down. We have to have a great recruiting year but we won't be hurting next year (on the defensive line). It is definitely the best thing that has happened to me at Auburn.
