QUOTES FROM MICHIGAN COACH BO SCHEMBECHLER

We just didn't play a very good second half. Our offense had opportunities. Our offensive line broke down in pass protection.

If you want to be critical, be critical of the offensive line. They were lousy.

I'm not making excuses. We come out here every year and lose by seven points. I can't explain that.

We just never had the ball in the second half. Then the first couple of times we didn't do anything with it.

The noise factor (from the crowd) was amazing. The sack by No. 88 (Skip McClendon) was a case of not hearing the play. Maybe someday, we'll get as many tickets as them (ASU).

The quarterback (Van Raaphorst) played extremely well. He made some great plays.

QUOTES FROM ASU COACH JOHN COOPER

This is the greatest win I've ever been associated with as a coach. It's my greatest thrill.

We were able to move the ball off the line, we made very few mistakes, and we didn't turn the ball over.

Michigan is the best team we've faced this year.

I've said all season that Jeff Van Raaphorst is the best quarterback on the West Coast. (At the end of the first half) I didn't feel we had the game won, but we certainly had some momentum. Our fans (all 70,000 or so) really helped us.

Our players played to their top ability level, and I feel that we had a better team today. Michigan is a great team, but we were quicker, especially on defense. I also felt that we were in good control of their running game. I felt that the only way that they could score was on a big play on the pass.

We have spent the whole season controlling the ball, but the secret to our success all season has been our ability to remain fundamentally sound.

QUOTES FROM ASU QUARTERBACK JEFF VAN RAAPHORST

I'm really happy not only for the coaches, but for everyone. All those fans who drove across I-10 - there's not much there except for Blythe and some cactus.

When I was a kid, I said "God, I'd like to play there (in the Rose Bowl) some day." You dream about playing here and now this.

Obviously, everyone is a little nervous at the start. We weren't very successful at first, but we adjusted and that's what won the game for us.

ROSE BOWL NOTES & RECORDS

- (1) SEASON RECORDS: Arizona State finished at 10-1-1, while Michigan finished 11-2. This was the first-ever meeting between the schools. Coming into the game, Michigan was ranked No. 4 by the Associated Press and ASU was ranked 7th by the AP.
- (2) MOST VALUABLE PLAYER: ASU quarterback Jeff Van Raaphorst was the game's MVP, the sixth straight year a Pac-10 player has been selected. The last Big 10 Rose Bowl MVP was in 1981, when Michigan tailback Butch Woolfolk was selected.
- (3) PAC-10 ROSE BOWL DOMINANCE: Pac-10 teams have won six Rose Bowl games in a row, 12 of the last 13 and are 16-2 from 1970-87. Since the inception of the Big 10-Pac-10 agreement in 1947, the Pac-10 has 22 to 19 for the Big 10.
- (4) INTERCONFERENCE PLAY: The Pac-10 finished the year with an interconference mark of 25-11-0, including 3-3 in bowl games. The Big 10's interconference record was 21-16-0, with a 2-3 mark in bowl games.
- (5) ARIZONA STATE IN THE ROSE BOWL: This was ASU's first appearance in the Rose Bowl. ASU is 8-5-1 in bowl games all-time.
- (6) MICHIGAN IN THE ROSE BOWL: Michigan is now 5-7 in Rose Bowls. Michigan is 7-11 in its all-time bowl games.
- (7) ROSE BOWL RECORDS:
- Individual passing: Jim Harbaugh of Michigan tied the Rose Bowl record for most passes intercepted with 3. The record is shared with six others, most recently Mike Tomczak of Ohio State vs. USC in 1985.
 - Individual pass receiving: Flanker Bruce Hill of ASU tied the game record for most TD receptions with 2. The record is shared by eight others and was done most recently by UCLA's Karl Dorrell vs. Illinois in 1984.
 - Individual Field Goals kicked: ASU's Kent Bostrom kicked three FGs today, tying the most ever in an RB game. He is the third person to do this: Rich Spangler of Ohio State did it vs. USC in 1985 and Vlade Janskiewski of Ohio State kicked three vs. USC in 1980.
