### MICHIGAN vs. MINNESOTA Post-Game Notes

COLLINS PASSES HIS WAY INTO RECORD-BOOK
Collins had 352 passing yards (15 completions on 27 attempts with three passing touchdowns and one interception), breaking the Michigan single-game most passing yards record formerly held by Jim Harbaugh, who had 310 passing yards (15 completions on 24 attempts with one touchdown and no interceptions) in a 34-17 victory over Wisconsin in 1986. With his 352-yard performance against Minnesota, Collins now has eight games in which he has passed for over 250 yards, which is the most by any quarterback in Michigan history.

# COLLINS NEARS SEASON RECORD

With his 352-passing yard performance against Minnesota, Collins raised his season passing yardage total to 2,196, passing Elvis Grbac (2,085 passing yards in 1991) into third place on the 'M' single-season list. Collins has 5,536 career passing yards, second only to Grbac who had 6,460 passing yards in 1989-92.

# WHEATLEY POINTS TO MICHIGAN SCORING RECORD

With his two touchdowns (a two-yard rushing TD and a 57-yard receiving TD) against Minnesota, Wheatley upped his Michigan career points scored total to 318, breaking the 'M' all-time record formerly held by Mike Gillette (307 in 1985-88). Wheatley's 318 points rank third on the Big Ten most points scored in a career list, just 30 points shy of tying Pete Johnson of Ohio State (348 in 1973-76), for second.

Wheatley has scored all of his points on touchdowns (53 overall TDs and 46 rushing TDs). Wheatley's 53 total touchdowns rank third on the Big Ten most touchdowns scored in a career list, just five shy of tying Johnson of Ohio State (58 in 1973-76) for second place. Wheatley's 46 career rushing touchdowns are tied for third with Keith Byars of Ohio State (46 in 1982-85) on the Big Ten rushing TDs list.

# TOTALING BIG YARDS

The Wolverines had 561 yards of total offense against the Golden Gophers (354 passing and 207 rushing), marking the second time that Michigan has gathered over 500 yards of total offense during the 1994 season (Michigan had 560 yards of total offense against Michigan: State). The last time that the Wolverines had over 600 yards of total offense was when they had 621 total yards in a 63-13 victory over Minnesota.

The two teams combined for 748 passing yards on the day (354 for Michigan, 394 for Minnesota), setting the record for the most combined passing yards in Michigan history. The previous record was 664 combined passing yards against Northwestern in 1982; Northwestern had 436 passing yards and Michigan had 228 passing yards on the day. Minnesota had 490 total yards of offense, making for 1,051 combined yards of offense between the two teams, which is the second most in Michigan history. The record is 1,139 total yards versus Illinois (Michigan had 645 total yards and Illinois had 494 total yards on the day) in 1981.

Michigan scored 18 of its 38 points in the third quarter against the Golden Gophers, continuing a season-long trend: the Wolverines have scored 115 of their 300 points (38.3 percent) in the third quarter. The second quarter has proven to be second best (82 points) for Michigan's point scoring production, while the fourth quarter (60 points) and the first quarter (43 points) have been the Wolverines' least productive point scoring quarters.

# PASSES TAILOR-MADE FOR AMANI

Wide receiver Amani Toomer had 147 receiving yards on six catches (24.5 yards per catch) and two touchdowns against the Golden Gophers, marking the third time during the 1994 season that Toomer has had over 100 receiving yards in a game (Toomer had 179 receiving yards against Boston College and had 157 receiving yards against Penn State). Toomer has 938 receiving yards on the season, which ranks fifth on the 'M' all-time list. If **Toomer** maintains his current 93.8 receiving yards per game average, he will amass a total of 1,126 receiving yards on the season, which would break the Michigan record currently held by **Jack** Clancy (1,079 receiving yards in 1966).

## FANTASTIC FIRSTS

Defensive back Woody Hankins had his first career interception against the Golden Gophers... Ty Law had his first interception of the season...Defensive tackle Glen Steele had his first fumble recovery against Minnesota. Tailback Chris Floyd had his first run of over ten yards with a 54-yard jaunt against the Golden Gophers... Walt Smith, who has been sidelined for the season with a knee injury, had his first catch of the 1994 campaign on a two-yard strike from Jason Carr.

## ATTENDANCE RECORD FALLS

Today's game drew a crowd of 105,624. The 1994 University of Michigan have drawn an average of 106,217 spectators (637,300 spectators in six games) to its home games, breaking the NCAA regular-season record for average home attendance. The record was previously held by the 1992 Wolverine team that played in front of an average of 105,867 spectators at Michigan Stadium. Including today's game against Minnesota, the Maize and Blue have now played 122 consecutive home games in front of crowds of 100,000 or more spectators. The last time the Wolverines played in front of less than 104,000 spectators was Nov. 9, 1991 versus Northwestern (102,087).

# MINNESOTA NOTABLES

Minnesota tailback Chris Darkins had 93 rushing yards on the day, upping his season rushing yard total to 1,255 and thereby breaking the Golden Gopher record for most rushing yards in a season formerly held by Derrell Thompson, who had 1,240 rushing yards in 1986...With his 13 receptions and 187 receiving yards on the day, Golden Gopher receiver Aaron Osterman moved into third in career receptions (106) and receiving yards (1,455) on the Minnesota all-time list. Minnesota scored 22 points against Michigan—the most points that a Golden Gopher team has produced against Michigan since they scored 23 points in a 23-20 victory over the Wolverines in 1961.

On Todd Collins

"I love Collins. He's a fine quarterback. I think he's going to be a great proquarterback. He's got receivers and backs, but he's just great."

On Minnesota's Offense

"It's not like we weren't throwing and catching well. Michigan's a fine football team. Our offense was great. I can't complain about our yardage, but turnovers hurt us."

On Tyrone Wheatley

"Wheatley, the kid's a Heisman winner--just watch."

Michigan's Record

"Colorado was lucky and Penn State is one of the finest teams in the country. Michigan is great, great club."

Minnesota's Defense

"We had good coverage, but with Toomer, Collins, and Hayes not to mention Wheatley and Biakabutuka, there's just so much you can do. I thought we played great defense, but Michigan just has a great team."

# MICHIGAN COACH GARY MOELLER

In General

"It was a big win. I didn't think we looked good in the first half. I like the way we bounced back."

On Todd Collins

"Todd Collins is a great quarterback. I didn't think he was as sure in the first half, but we expect him to throw every pass perfectly. I told him at the half that everybody looks to you to make things happen. He has a good touch and he's going to be missed."

On the Pass to Walter Smith

"Walter has been planning that for three weeks. The doctors told him not to run full speed, but he wanted to block a man. I told him if there was a chance in the game, we'll throw him a pass. I was trying to show how much this team loves Walter Smith. It was a nice moment, I was glad we had a chance to do it."

On Michigan's Lack of Emotion Early in the Game

"There was a flatness. They (Minnesota) got excited when we goofed up a little. They (Minnesota) created it (Flatness). I thought we were up mentally and we were focused at the start, but it was like we lost our breath."

On Minnesota's Defensive Coverage

"The last 21 snaps on third and long, Minnesota had played man-to-man, but they gave us some zone and confused us. They didn't play as much man as they did against other teams, but it was the most we'd seen all year."

On Ohio State

"We've got to play one game... one big game."
