Post-Game Notes Michigan vs. Miami

Tailback Tshimanga Biakabutuka and wide receivers Mercury Hayes and Amani Toomer scored touchdowns and Remy Hamilton kicked three field goals to help Michigan to a 38-19 win over Miami University. The Wolverines held a 31-0 half-time advantage before the Redskins scored 19 consecutive third-quarter points. Sophomore quarterback Brian Griese made a successful starting debut, completing 14-of-24 passes for 192 yards and touchdowns to Hayes and Toomer.

HAYES GETS ONE HUNDRED

With six catches for 107 yards, Michigan wide receiver Mercury Hayes recorded his fourth 100-yard receiving game, tying him for fifth on the all-time list. Hayes' first-quarter touchdown reception gives him 11 for his career, good for a ninth-place tie on the all-time list. He also went over the 100 career receptions mark, passing Jamie Morris (99 receptions, 1984-87) for eighth place on the all-time receptions list. Next up is Greg McMurtry (111, 1986-89). Hayes also moved up to seventh on the all-time receiving yardage list, passing Jim Smith (1,687, 1973-76). Next up is Jack Clancy (1,919, 1963-66).

TOOMER'S NAME ON PASS LIST

Senior wide receiver Amani Toomer (three catches for 40 yards) moved into sole possession of sixth place on the all-time receptions list with 114. His 32-yard punt return in the second quarter was Michigan's longest punt return of the season, besting Anthony Williams' 28-yarder (blocked kick for a touchdown) at Illinois.

HAMILTON KICKS IN

Junior kicker Remy Hamilton's three field goals moved him into sole possession of third place (34) on the Michigan all-time list for career field goals. Next up is J.D. Carlson (1988-91) with 39. Hamilton also currently stands in a tie for first in Michigan history for field-goal accuracy (34-41, 82.9 percent) with Bob Bergeron (1981-84).

DEFENSE PASSES '94 PICK MARK

Chuck Winters' first-quarter interception return for a touchdown gave the Michigan defense eight interceptions on the season, equaling the team's 1994 season total. It marked the first Michigan interception for a touchdown since the 1994 Hall of Fame Bowl, when Clarence Thompson ran a pick back 43 yards for a score against North Carolina State.

FAST STARTS

Michigan's 21 first-quarter points were the most since the Wolverines scored the same amount on Nov. 7, 1992 at Northwestern. The school record is 24 points, set against Northwestern in 1991. The Wolverines have yet to surrender a first-quarter point this season, holding a 35-0 advantage in the first 15 minutes. In the first half, the Wolverines hold a 68-13 edge.

125 AND COUNTING

The attendance of 104,484 gave Michigan its 125th consecutive game of 100,000-plus fans.

ALIVE AT FIVE

The last 10 times Michigan has taken a four-game winning streak into a game, the Wolverines successfully stretched it to five. The last time U-M failed to win a fifth consecutive game was 1981, when it lost to Ohio State, 14-9, in the final regular-season game.

DeLONG BOOT

Sophomore punter Nate DeLong's 65-yard kick in the fourth quarter was the longest of his career. Michigan's last 60-yard kick came in the 1994 Hall of Fame bowl, when Chris Stapleton kicked a 60-yarder against North Carolina State.

TRY FOR TWO

Michigan's two-point conversion in the first quarter was its first successful attempt since Nov. 12, 1994, when Todd Collins hit Toomer for the additional points against Minnesota.

MAC ATTACK

Michigan is now 9-0 all-time against current opponents from the Mid-American Conference.

MIAMI NOTES

Chad Seitz' 54-yard field goal in the third quarter broke the Miami school record of 53, which was held by Gary Gussman at Cincinnati in 1987. The FG was the fourth-longest successful kick by a Michigan opponent ... Seitz also moved into second place on the Miami all-time scoring list, with a new career total of 206 points ... Deland McCullough (28 carries, 141 yards) now has 18 100-yard rushing games, tying the school record held by George Swarn.
