Post-Game Notes Michigan vs. Ohio State

Michigan junior tailback **Tshimanga Blakabutuka** rushed for a career-high 313 yards and one touchdown, and freshman **Clarence Williams** caught one touchdown pass and rushed for another, as Michigan won 31-23 and denied Ohio State a trip to the Rose Bowl for the second time in three seasons at Michigan Stadium.

BIAKABUTUKA SECOND TO ONE

Tshimanga Biakabutuka became just the second player in Michigan history to rush for more than 300 yards in a game. Ron Johnson holds the all-time record for rushing yards in a game with 347 vs. Wisconsin on Nov. 16, 1968 (W, 34-9). Biakabutuka also broke the record for most rushing yards in a season (1,724). Jamie Morris held the previous record of 1,703, set in 1987. Biakabutuka also set a record by becoming one of only five Michigan players to have two 200-yard rushing games in the same season. The other four are: Tom Harmon (1939), Ron Johnson (1968), Jon Vaughn (1990) and Tyrone Wheatley (1992).

MORE BIAKABUTUKA

Biakabutuka moved up to eighth place on Michigan's all-time rushing list. With 2,716 career yards, Biakabutuka trails **Lawrence Ricks** (2,751 from 1979-82) for seventh place. With 313 rushing and 13 kickoff return yards, Biakabutuka recorded the fourth-best single-game all-purpose yardage mark (326) in Michigan history. Ron Johnson holds the record with 387 against Wisconsin (W, 34-9) on Nov. 16, 1968.

WOODSON WITH TWO

Freshman comerback Charles Woodson became the first Wolverine to intercept two passes in a game since Ty Law picked off a pair of passes against Ohio State in Michigan's 28-0 victory on Nov. 20, 1994.

FABULOUS IN THE FIRST

With a first-quarter field goal, Ohio State became only the second team this season to score against the Michigan defense in the first quarter. Indiana also kicked a first-quarter field goal on Nov. 21. With a first-quarter touchdown against the Buckeyes, the Wolverines expanded their scoring margin in the first quarter of games this season to 82-6.

100,000-PLUS STREAK INTO 1996

A crowd of 106,288—the ninth-largest in Michigan Stadium history—saw the Wolverines beat the Buckeyes, and ensures Michigan's streak of 100,000-plus fans will carry into a 22nd consecutive season. Begun on Nov. 8, 1975 in a 28-0 victory over Purdue in front of a crowd of 102,415, the streak now stands at 129 games heading to 1996.

POST-GAME QUOTES FROM THE MICHIGAN PRESS ROOM

Head Coach Lloyd Carr:

(On the game in general...) "It's been a long season and I can't think of a better way to end than these kids did this afternoon. The effort by those kids was unbelievable."

(On the scene in the locker room at the end of the game...) "It's a moment I'll never forget. They were ready to sing "The Victors" and they wouldn't let me down. I led them in singing "The Victors."

(More on the game in general...) "I want to give credit to Ohio State. They (the Buckeyes) are a great football team and it was a great credit to our kids to take a game plan and overcome some mistakes (penalties and interceptions) to win the game.

"I don't think anybody in the country gave us much of a chance, but I told our kids it's not important what the other people think but what the people on our side believe. And we believed."

(On answering the question of whether or not this was the biggest win of his career...) "I don't think there could be a bigger one, but I hope there is."

(On Tshimanga Biakabutuka...) "I was concerned about our mental state after the loss at Penn State. Tshimanga came into my office on Sunday night with a smile on his face and said, 'I'll be ready. I'll take this as a personal challenge. I want to prove I am the best back in the conference.' He made a statement today, but don't forget the players up front (offensive linemen)."

(On whether the comments from Terry Glenn helped motivate the team...) "I don't think it hurt us."

(On the game in general...) "I told the team the game would go down to the final two minutes. If the offense was on the field we would have to move down the field and if the defense was playing we would have to get them stopped, and we did."

(On Brian Griese...) Anytime you are the quarterback on a team that beats Ohio State you've done a lot of good things."

FROM THE OHIO STATE PRESS ROOM

Head Coach John Cooper:

(On the outcome of the game...) "I am tremendously disappointed. I don't know if I've ever been so disappointed in my life as I am right now sitting here today. I'm disappointed not only for my coaches but I am probably more disappointed for the senior football players. They have never been to a Rose Bowl. I've been to the Rose Bowl and it's a great experience."

(On the season in general...) "We've had a great year. We were 11-0 coming up here but today if you can't stop the running game in this league and if you can't run the football you are going to get beat, and that's what happened to us today."

(On the play of the Buckeyes...) "They beat us up front unmercifully. We didn't protect our quarterback and we didn't establish a running game like we have in some of the other ball games. We never stopped their running game. Right up until the end of the ball game they were able to move the ball, get first downs and keep our offense on the sidelines."

(On the play of the Wolverines...) "Give them credit. They'd played an outstanding ball game. I said coming up here that I don't know how in the world they've lost three ball games. They play like that and nobody is going to beat them."

(On the game in general...) "Biakabutuka is a great back, we knew that coming up here. They had a good game plan. They got us running and cut the ball back against the grain time and time and time again, and I am proud of our football team for hanging in there and playing as tough as they did and fighting back. Right up to the end I thought we had a chance to score and tie the ball game but we didn't get it done."

(On Ohio State's offense...) "We had the ball inside their 10 on a couple of different occasions and came away with field goals instead of touchdowns, and that is something we haven't had to do so far this year. Anytime you have to kick three field goals and settle for those field goals rather than touchdowns against a team as hot as they were today you are going to get beat and that's what happened."

(On what he told the team after the game...) "I told them that obviously I am disappointed for them, but we have come a long way and won 11 football games. We are not going to the Rose Bowl, but we are going to the Citrus Bowl, and I imagine we will probably play Tennessee. We've got a choice now of whether we bounce back and win 12 ball games or go down there and let them pound on us."

(On Michigan...) "They knocked us out of the Rose Bowl and they played an outstanding football game. Give them credit, certainly the only thing they did was keep us from going to the Rose Bowl, but that's the main thing. We won 11 football games and I am proud of the team for doing that, but I'm tremendously disappointed that we didn't go all the way."
