WOLVERINES EXTEND ATTENDANCE STREAK

Today's announced crowd of 105,898 fans pushed Michigan's streak of consecutive crowds over 100,000 fans to 135 games. The streak began on Nov. 8, 1975 versus Purdue and is now in its 21st season. The last crowd of less than 100,000 fans was Oct. 25 against Indiana.

HOWARD SCORES 10TH TD; RUSHES FOR 120 YARDS

Junior running back **Chris Howard (River Ridge, LA)** scored Michigan's go-ahead touchdown in the third quarter on a 27-yard scamper (his team leading 10th). Howard tallied his fourth 100-yard rushing performance of the year, gaining 120 yards on 28 carries.

CARR HAS BIG DAY

Junior nose tackle **William Carr (Dallas, TX)** recovered a Wally Richardson lateral to set up the Wolverines go ahead touchdown on the first possession of the third quarter. In addition to his fumble recovery, Carr had six tackles (five solo, one assist) on the day. Four of his tackles were for a loss (14 yards), bringing his career total to 38 [tied for fourth with **Robert Thompson (1979-82)** and **Chris Hutchinson (1989-92)**]. His total of 14 TFL on the year ties him with **David Bowens** for the team lead.

SHEA SCORES FIRST CAREER TOUCHDOWN

Sophomore/freshman tight end **Aaron Shea (Ottawa, IL)** caught the first touchdown reception of his Michigan career in the second quarter on a 25-yard pass from Scott Dreisbach. Making his first career start, Shea's shoe-string, diving grab in the right corner of the end zone was a career best. He has four catches for 40 yards on the year.

WOLVERINES START THREE TIGHT ENDS

The trio of Aaron Shea, **Jerame Tuman (Liberal, KS)**, and **Mark Campbell (Clawson, MI)** all started the game at tight end for the Wolverines today. This marked the first time Michigan has started three tight ends in a game during the 1996 season. All three played a big part in the offensive game plan, combining for five receptions for 85 yards. Tuman has started all 10 games, led the trio with three catches for 43 yards.

WOODSON EVERYWHERE

Sophomore **Charles Woodson (Fremont, OH)** was utilized to his potential today, starting at cornerback, playing wide receiver, and returning kickoffs and punts. He had three kickoff return for 63 yards, including a career-high 23 yarder. He also returned punts for the first time in his career with three attempts for 16 yards, with a 15 yard long. Defensively, Woodson had a career-high 11 tackles (eight solo, three assists) and one pass broken up. His 11 pass broken up shares the team lead with **Woodrow Hankins**.

EXTRA POINTS: Michigan dropped its first game when losing the coin toss in 1996 (8-1) ... Penn State's six first quarter points were the most scored against the Wolverines during the first quarter all season (Michigan's defense has yet to surrender a first quarter touchdown) ... For the second straight game, Michigan was held scoreless in the first quarter ... The 13 first half points scored by Penn State was the most allowed by the Michigan defense to an opponent in the opening half all season (Indiana scored 17 points in the first half but seven came on an interception return for a touchdown) ... **Remy Hamilton's** 33-yard field goal in the second quarter moved him within six of the Big Ten career field goal record of 65 set by Wisconsin's Todd Gregoire ... Linebacker **Jarrett Irons (The Woodlands, TX)** sacked Wally Richardson to thwart Penn State's two-point conversion attempt in the third quarter ... Penn State's 29 points tied Michigan State for the most scored against the Wolverines in 1996 ... Sophomore wide receiver **Tai Streets (Matteson, IL)** led the Wolverines with six catches for 93 yards, his second best reception day of the year.

PENN STATE NOTES

Curtis Enis became the eighth Nittany Lion to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. Enis rushed for 114 yards on 21 carries today.

Curtis Enis broke the Penn State record for receptions in a season by a running back with six. The old record was 26 set by D.J. Dozier in 1986.

Kim Herring intercepted two interceptions on the day, raising his team leading total to six. He now has 12 interceptions on his career.

David Macklin blocked one punt, recovered by Ahmad Collins for his first career touchdown. Macklin also partially blocked another punt.

Shawn Lee made his fourth interception of the season on a ball tipped by Kim Herring. Also, Mark Tate collected his first interception of the season.

Joe Jurevicus made a career high six receptions (59 yards). His previous high was five set at Wisconsin earlier this year.

The Lions forced six turnovers (four interceptions, one fumble recovery, one blocked punt), giving Penn State 15 turnovers forced in the last three games.
