Coaches' Quotes

OHIO STATE HEAD COACH JOHN COOPER

"I'm obviously very, very disappointed with how we played offensively. No question about it, we had the ball down on their end of the field three times in the first half and we had to settle for field goals. I thought we dominated the first half. Even at halftime I felt very good about our chances, we were leading 9-0.

"They came out in the second half with a new quarterback (Brian Griese) and were throwing a short passing game and Shawn Springs fell down on the slant and they take the ball in for a touchdown. They made the big play. We were playing man coverage. It seemed like from that point on, they had the momentum in the ballgame. They had a spark that got them some life and won the game.

"I thought our defense played good enough to win the game. We just didn't get the job done in the second half offensively. We just didn't make plays today.

"They are a good defensive football team. Again, we got the ball in the red zone and couldn't do anything with it. We just didn't get it done offensively.

"I thought up until the ballgame was over that we had a chance to come back and win this thing. We didn't get anything. We couldn't connect on third downs, on second downs, on anything. I'm tremendously disappointed with our offense. We absolutely didn't do anything offensively in the second half. We had the ball in the second half on the 4, which is good field position, where a field goal would win you the game. And we didn't do anything.

"I am tremendously disappointed and feel bad for our senior players. We had a golden opportunity to beat Michigan today and be one of the best teams in Ohio State history. And we didn't get the job done. We didn't make the big plays and we didn't play good enough to win. You have to make the big plays. No one on our team made a big play today.

THE QUARTERBACK SITUATION: "We thought Joe Germaine would give us the best opportunity to win the game. We played Joe in the first quarter. We brought Stan (Jackson) off the bench in the second quarter, then made a decision at halftime. We thought we had some opportunities in the second quarter (with Stanley Jackson as QB) to pass the ball and we had some receivers open, but he didn't get the ball to them. So, we felt like Joe would give us the best chance (to win the game) in the second half.

"They made every play and we didn't, that was the difference in the ballgame. We didn't take the fight away from them in the second half.

"We have had a good year, but it's not a great year when you don't beat Michigan. No excuses, now we have to win the Rose Bowl."

MICHIGAN HEAD COACH LLOYD CARR

"This was a great win for us over a great football team. I'm extremely proud of the effort and the determination of our team. We came here expecting to win and we talked about what we had to do to win. It was a players' game, like most of these Ohio State-Michigan games are. It was won on the field by a group of guys that believed they could win.

"It's always emotional when you beat Ohio State. Three weeks ago, we were in a position to reach our goals, which was to win the Big Ten championship, and then we faltered. Then we lost again. Anytime you're coming off two losses at Michigan, you're down. I can't say we weren't down because we were. But, we didn't stay down and that's what athletics are all about.

"At the half I felt very good with the exception of the last field goal, which our offense did not do a good job. Then they hit one pass and got the ninth point. But we talked last night about that if we were close in the fourth quarter, we knew we would win. We just couldn't make a lot of mistakes against a team like Ohio State, who particularly defensively had caused so many turnovers throughout the year and created so many great scoring opportunities. If we didn't make mistakes and kept it close until the fourth quarter. In the second half we wore them down a little bit and that last drive was a thing of beauty.

"Last spring, Brian Griese handled a very awkward situation with tremendous class. He came back this fall and battled. Here's a guy who had started nine games and had beaten Ohio State a year ago and one of his goals was to do everything within his power to get this team to the Rose Bowl. And the role he was asked to play was to be the backup quarterback and nobody has done a greater job. He has handled a disappointing situation with everything you could ever ask a guy to do. I'm thrilled to death that he could come off the bench and lead this team to such a great victory.

"We stayed with our game plan even when we were down. We felt we had to establish a running game early in the game and that was difficult to do because they did a good job.

TODAY'S CROWD—Today's crowd of 94,676 is the sixth largest in Ohio Stadium history.

LOWEST POINT TOTAL SINCE 1993—The nine points scored by Ohio State was the lowest point total scored by an OSU team since a 28-0 loss to Michigan in 1993.

LOSS SNAPS HOME STREAK—Ohio State's loss at home today snapped a streak of 14 consecutive wins at home. The Buckeyes were 5-0 at Ohio Stadium this year.

FIRST BACK OVER 100 YARDS THIS YEAR—Michigan's Chris Howard rushed for 105 yards on 25 carries and is the first back to rush for over 100 yards versus the Buckeyes this year.

SECOND HALF SURGE—Michigan outgained OSU in total yards in the second half by a 237 to 84 yard margin. At the half, Ohio State had 220 yards and Michigan 62. The Buckeyes outgained the Wolverines 304 to 299 for the game.

FIRST CAREER START—Sophomore quarterback Joe Germaine made his first career start for the Buckeyes and played all but two possessions in the game. On the day Germaine was 12-31 for 148 yards, with one interception on the final play of the game. It was the games only turnover.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS—Junior tailback Pepe Pearson continues his rise up the OSU single-season rushing charts. With his 117 yards in the game he passed Calvin Murray (1,267, 1980) and Raymont Harris (1,344, 1993) to move into eighth place with 1,373 yards. Pearson

FIRST QUARTER BLUES OVER—After three consecutive games without scoring in the first quarter, the Buckeyes finally tallied a field goal for a 3-0 lead at the end of the first quarter.

STANLEY JACKSON—Junior quarterback Stanley Jackson entered the game at 10:59 of the second quarter and led the Buckeyes to a field goal in one of the two possessions he played in the first half. On the day Jackson was 1-4 for 9 yards. He did not play in the second half.

DEJA VU—By notching three field goals in the first half to give the Buckeyes a 9-0 lead, senior place-kicker Josh Jackson duplicated the same feat he accomplished in last year's game in Ann Arbor, but Michigan led 10-9. The three field goals tied his career high.

NO TOUCHDOWNS—Michigan has not allowed a touchdown in the first quarter all season. The last team to score a first quarter TD against UM in a regular season game was Purdue in 1994.

RECEIVING STREAK—Jerame Tuman, Tai Streets, Russell Shaw and Clarence Williams continued their streak of catching a pass in every game this season.

OVER 2,000 PASSING—With 29 yards passing today, Scott Dreisbach became the fourth quarterback in Michigan history to record at least 2,000 passing yards in one season. The only other Wolverines to pass for 2,000 yards in a season are current NFL players Jim Harbaugh, Elvis Grbac and Todd Collins (who did it twice).

LONGEST OF YEAR—Michigan's 69-yard scoring pass from Brian Grease to Tai Streets was the team's longest pass play this season. The previous passing long was a 58-yarder from Scott Dreisbach to Jermane Tuman vs. Boston College.

NO DREISBACH—Brian Grease's second half start marked the first time this season Michigan has had a quarterback other than Dreisbach start either half. For the day, Greise was 8-14 for 120 yards and a touchdown. Those totals surpassed his entire season totals of 6 of 10 for 106 yards.

RECORD GOES UP—Remy Hamilton's 43-yard field goal in the third quarter was his 12th consecutive field goal and extended his Michigan record to 61 field goals.
