Post-Game Notes and Highlights

Golden Fifties

David Terrell (*Richmond, Va./Huguenot*) made five receptions in the game to reach 53 receptions in a season. He is the ninth receiver to reach the 50-catch plateau. He scored his fifth touchdown for the season on a pass from Brady in the first quarter to put the Wolverines up 6-0. Terrell also made the first interception of his career while palying his 5th or 6th game this season at defensive back. He had a pass break-up and was Player of the Game on ESPN Plus.

Career High

Tom Brady (*San Mateo, Calif./Serra*) tallied his 27th touchdown pass of his career with a pass to Terrell to open the scoring for the day. The touchdown pass also marked Brady's 14th straight Big Ten Conference game with a touchdown pass. Brady reached a career high with three touchdown passes in a single game. The third touchdown came on an 11 yard pass to **Bennie Joppru** (*Wayzata, Minn./Minnetonka*) to put the Wolverines up 33-0 in the third quarter. Tom Brady passes John Wangler on the Michigan all-time career passes thown list to put himself at seventh for 27 touchdowns.

Anthony Thomas (*Winnfield, La./Winnfield*), who wears No. 32, has 34 rushing touchdowns in 33 games career games. His 33rd touchdown was a 60 yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter that put the Wolverines up 19-0. Thomas also scored his 34th career touchdown, 14th this season, on a one yard run in the second quarter to put Michigan up 26-0. Thomas' two rushing touchdowns of the game ties him with Rick Leach for second on the Michigan all-time career rushing touchdown list.

Rushing Thomas

Thomas is the first player to reach the 1,000 yard plateau in a single season since Tshimanga Biakabatuka in 1995 went for a single season Michigan record 1,818 yards. He reached the mark on a 26 yard run to tally 1,005 yards. Thomas has gone over the 100-yard mark five times this season and for the first time in his career has had three consecutive 100-yard plus games.

M Team Rushing

Michigan's 225 yard rushing gives it a new season best for the second consecutive week. Michigan set its team season high with 213 versus Indiana (Oct. 30), but surpassed that mark with 223 on 42 carries.

Touchdown-less in Three Game

By holding Northwestern to three points today, the Wolverines have now held the Wildcats without a touchdown in three consecutive games. Not since the fourth quarter of the 1996 meeting between the two schools did Northwestern score a touchdown against Michigan. Since 1996, Michigan has held Northwestern to two field goals and six points in each of the last to meetings in 1997 and 1998.

First Timers

Cato June (*Washington, D.C./Anacostia*) made his first career start today at free safety. **Kurt Anderson** (*Glenbrook, Ill./South*) made his first appearance on offense today since playing defense prior to today's game. **Deitan Dubuc** (*Fabreville, Quebec/Vieux Montreal*) made his first career reception on a 23 yard pass from Jason Kapsner in the fourth quarter. **Brandon Kornblue** (*Boca Raton, Fla./Boca Raton*) made his first career appearance today scoring a field goal to put Michigan up 37-3 and to end the scoring of the game. Nose tackle **Jason Ptak** (*Wyabdotte, Mich./Roosevet*) has his first career sack for ten yards.

Two-Way Freshman

Ronald Bellamy (*New Orleans, La./Archbishop Shaw*) made his first defensive appearance this afternoon playing cornerback. Bellamy also played wide receiver and joins David Terrell and Marcus Knight as the only Wolverines to play both ways in the same game this season.

Knight Continues Climb

Marcus Knight (*Sylacauga, Ala./Comer*) tallied his fourth touchdown this season on a 45 yard pass from Brady in the second quarter to put the Wolverine up 12-0. Knight moved up to 13th all-time in receiving yards, jumping ahead of Ralph Clayton. Today's start at wide receiver marked his 20th start.

James Hall (*New Orleans, la./St. Augustine*), **Tommy Hendricks** (*Houston, Texas/Eisenhower*), **Josh Williams** (*Houston, Texas/Cypress Creek*) played their 45th career games today. Hendricks and **Rob Renes** (*Holland, Mich./West Ottawa*) made their 34th career starts and **Steve Hutchison** (*Coral Springs, Fla./Coral Springs*) made his 30th. **Eric Brackins** (*Pigeon Forge, Tenn./Gatlingburg Pittman*) also played in his 20th career game.

Head Coach Lloyd Carr:

Carr on the game: We needed this game because we need some enthusiasm. I think we're beginning to play the way we're capable of playing. We made some strides defensively. I feel good about our mental toughness going into the next game.
