FOOTBALL COACH CONTRACT.

This agreement entered into this 20th day of December, 1901, between F. H. Yost and Charles Baird for the University of Michigan Athletic Association stipulates as follows:

FIRST. That Mr. Yost shall coach to the best of his knowledge and ability the University of Michigan Football Team for the seasons of 1902, 1903, 1904, holding himself in readiness to report on September first of each year, if so requested, and continuing until the last game is played. In case of absence from duty a proportionate amount of salary shall be deducted from such payments according to the time lost.

SECOND. In consideration of coaching the Michigan Football Team faithfully and well, Mr. Yost shall be paid by the University of Michigan Athletic Association the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$2750.00) for each season he coaches in the following payments:

October 1st,	\$300.00✓	November 1st,	\$500.00✓
October 15,	\$500.00✓	November 15,	\$500.00✓
		December 1st,	\$950.00.

In addition to the above salary, Mr. Yost shall also receive from the University of Michigan Athletic Association a sum sufficient to cover his living expenses in Ann Arbor during the coaching season. These expenses mean board at the training table and a reasonable amount for the payment of room rent.

Third - It is understood and agreed by both parties, that if Mr. F. H. Yost desires to stop coaching permanently, he may terminate this contract by notice at the close of any of the seasons specified above.
